HOUSE NUMBERS

§101. Display of House Number.

Each building to which a street number has been assigned shall display such number on the background of contrasting color in a position easily observed and readable from the public right-of-way (which shall include the marking of driveways or freestanding mailboxes where conditions necessitate). All numbers shall be in Arabic numerals at least three inches high and 1/2 inch stroke.

§102. Obligation of Property Owner.

It shall be the obligation of the owners of the property to which the numbers are being assigned to comply with the standards set by this Part and the proper officers of the Borough of Greenville.

§103. Reporting by the Municipality.

A properly verified copy of the address numbering system shall be reported and delivered by municipality to the proper officers of the Mercer County Enhanced 911.

§104. Penalty.

Failure of a property owner to comply with this Part shall constitute a summary offense and shall subject said owner to a fine not to exceed \$300.
