4. Presentation of 2011 proposed budget

Council President Shipley, on behalf of Councilors Urey and Auchter, commended Mr. Andrejchak and Mrs. Vale for their hard work on the 2011 budget. He added hiring a manager with ten years of experience in finance was a good selection for the borough. Mr. Andrejchak reviewed the proposed budget department by department, answering questions and explaining major changes to individual line items. Council President Shipley announced there is no tax increase in 2011. Mrs. Auchter credited Mrs. Vale and Mr. Andrejchak for the easiest budget preparation in her eight years on the Finance Committee.

6. Public comments on 2011 proposed budget

Kate Yasgur, 193 Clinton Street, complimented Mr. Andrejchak on the new look of the budget document.

7. NEW BUSINESS

A. Mrs. Auchter reported the code officer is scheduled to work 32 hours a week and the Code Committee recommends an additional 8 hours a week, to make the position full time. Motion by Councilor Jones, seconded by Councilor Auchter, to accept the recommendation from the Code Committee to increase the code officer from part time to full time status with benefits effective November 1, 2010. Motion carried.

B. Motion by Councilor Peden, seconded by Councilor Auchter, to accept the recommendation of the Street Committee to rent a street sweeper for the month of November for approximately \$8,000, with the option to purchase the machine at a future date with council approval. Motion carried.

8. Adjournment

Having no other business before council, motion by Councilor Urey, seconded by Councilor May, to adjourn at 7:26p.m.to Greenville High School Lecture hall for a public forum on Greenville Memorial Swimming Pool. Motion carried.
