

ORDINANCE NO. 1643

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF GREENVILLE, MERCER COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF
GREENVILLE, CODIFIED CHAPTER 350, THEREOF ENTITLED
“PARKS AND RECREATION AREAS”.**

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Greenville, Mercer County, Pennsylvania, it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1: Section 350-1, Prohibited actions in all parks and recreation places, of Chapter 350, Parks and Recreation Area, of the code of the Town of Greenville is hereby amended to add a prohibited activity to sub-section C to read as follows:

§350-1(C) The feeding, disturbing, annoying, striking, injuring, or killing of any wild animal or bird shall be prohibited.

SECTION 2: All other provisions of the said Code of Ordinances of the Town of Greenville, not inconsistent herewith shall remain in full force and effect.
