*Agency Mission Statement:*

*The mission of the Greenville Police Department is to enhance the quality of life in Greenville and West Salem by working in partnership with the community within the framework of the U.S. Constitution. We will accomplish our mission by enforcing the law with impartiality and courtesy, fostering a feeling of safety and security, and providing quality police services to all persons within The Borough of Greenville and West Salem Township.*

During 2019 the department has seen a drastic change in our personnel, which has continued since 2018. The department has increased in size to 8 Full-Time Officers from 7 Full-Time Officers. This is due to providing a School Resource Officer to Keystone Charter School. The department now has 2 School Resource Officers (SRO). One at Greenville High School and the other at Keystone Charter School. Unfortunately in today's society we have seen a huge increase in SRO's in our schools. This is due to increased violence directed at some of our most vulnerable individuals and institutions. This department and the local school(s) and school board(s) have taken this threat very seriously and will do everything in our power and control to protect them.

The department has relied on specialized trainings for all officers. Some of the trainings they have been to are: Crisis Intervention Training (CIT)/De-escalation; Search and Seizure; Testifying in Court; Report Writing, and other continuing education courses, for the younger officers. For the senior officers. They have been trained in Leading without Rank, Use of Force and Deadly Encounters, Leadership and Communication, and Crisis Intervention Training. This will continue in 2020 with an emphasis on training the next leaders of the department.

As for crime in our community. We have seen a decrease in some areas and an increase in others. Since 2017 we have seen a decrease in Burglaries, but we have seen an increase in Thefts in that same time period. The Opioid Epidemic had hit our community hard as it had every community throughout the United States. In 2017, we had 33 Drug Overdoses reported with 1 death. In 2019, there were 6 Drug Overdoses reported with 1 death. The numbers have decreased, but are still high. The department has worked with the Behavioral Commission to provide our officers with Naloxone and they have been carrying it since 2017.

There are several crimes that have increased significantly over the past 2 years. Sexual Assault cases had increased from 8 in 2017 to 20 in 2019. (Sexual Assaults are still considered under reported in the United States) Assaults have increased from 60 in 2017 to 93 in 2019. The largest increase we have experienced is in Driving Under the Influence (DUI). (DUI's include alcohol and drugs.) In 2017 there were 23 arrests for DUI and in 2019 there were 93 arrests. 39 of the DUI arrests in 2019 were for drugs or a combination of alcohol/drugs compared to 8 in 2017.

Another problem area that affects just not our community, but every community is Domestic Violence and Mental Health. As with Sexual Assault cases, Domestic Violence and Mental Health issues are considered under reported. We have not seen a big increase or decrease in these areas, but have staid pretty consistent over the past couple years. We do work closely with AWARE and the Behavioral Health Commission, which provide training to the local departments. These agencies also provide assistant to victims of Domestic Violence and persons with Mental Health issues.

For the community we live in and work in. Is still a safe community. I believe this is due to the dedication of the Police Officers and the support our department receives from the community they serve.

In 2020, we will strive to provide an even better service for the community. This will be accomplished by continuing to educate the officers with the needs of the department and community in mind.

We will continue to use Social Media to provide the community with information about our department, community activities and other information that benefits the community.
