1. (831) Rental Inspections were conducted.
2. (369) Commercial Fire Inspections were conducted.
3. (1,200) Total Inspections conducted.
4. Firefighters completed maintenance on all fire apparatus and tested over 8,000ft of fire hose
5. Firefighters installed approximately 125 new smoke detectors and installed approximately 50 new smoke detector batteries in residences across the borough.
6. Set a record for most incidents ever with 1,206. Only 117 of these were assists to other Departments outside of the borough.
