Listed below are other activities performed my Firefighters other than dispatched incidents from 911.

- 1. (831) Rental Inspections were conducted.
- 2. (369) Commercial Fire Inspections were conducted.
- 3. (1,200) Total Inspections conducted.
- 4. Firefighters completed maintenance on all fire apparatus and tested over 8,000ft of fire hose
- 5. Firefighters installed approximately 125 new smoke detectors and installed approximately 50 new smoke detector batteries in residences across the borough.
- 6. Set a record for most incidents ever with 1,206. Only 117 of these were assists to other Departments outside of the borough.
