## 2017 FARMER'S MARKET RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Paul Hamil (724) 588-4333 will serve as Market Manager. He will see that parking spaces and rules and regulations are being followed and will work directly with the Borough of Greenville's Council representative to the farm market.
2. The market will be located on Penn Avenue between Main and Clinton Streets. It will open May 01, 2017 and the final day will be November 04, 2017. The market will be held on Mondays from 9:00am to 2:00pm, Wednesdays from 11:00am to 6:00pm and Saturdays from 9:00am to 2:00pm.
3. Any farmer who adheres to the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture Farmers Market Nutrition Program and lives within a 50 mile radius of Greenville may become a vendor. Craft vendors will be allowed as long as their crafts are handmade and must adhere to all Farm Market rules and regulations.
4. The fee for all vendors will be \$25.00 per month, with November permits free to all vendors paid in October. A one (1) month discount will be given to all vendors who purchase their permit for the entire farm market season (May-Oct). The fee will be paid at the borough building and a permit will be issued. The permit will be good from the 1<sup>st</sup> to the last day of each month and must be shown at the market (**no partial permits will be issued**). The parking spaces will remain the same and Paul Hamill, Market Manager, will assign space to any new vendors.
5. The market manager and a borough representative have the option to inspect the produce being grown by the vendor.
6. All state and local sanitary rules must be observed and at the end of each market day occupants in the market area must remove all refuse and animal droppings occasioned by their operations. You must provide your own display tables and appropriate signs. Do not use the park receptacles.
7. The Borough of Greenville reserves the right to revoke the permit of anyone violating any regulations prescribed. In such cases no future permit will be issued. The right is also reserved to make such changes in the market regulations as conditions may require from time to time, but no such change shall invalidate a permit issued for the period in which such changes are made.
8. Alcoholic beverages are prohibited, as well as the use of profanity.
