2017 Farmer's Market Rules & Regulations

1. The Farmer's Market will be located on Penn Avenue between Main Street and Clinton Street for produce selling vendors.
2. The Farmer's Market season will be from May 4, 2017, to November 2, 2017.
3. The Farmer's Market will be open between 9:00am and 8:00pm on Monday's, Wednesday's, and Saturday's.
4. All vendors are required to have a vendor's permit issued by the Borough of Greenville. Application for permits must be approved by the Borough Manager and require:
 - A processing fee of \$20.00.
 - A photocopy of the applicant's driver's license.
5. Permits must be displayed in the windshield of the vendor's motor vehicle at all times that the vendor is located at the Farmer's Market. A lost or misplaced permit can be replaced by the Borough Manager for a fee of \$10.00.
6. The Borough of Greenville may revoke the permit of any vendor who is determined by the Borough Manager to not be in compliance with the Farmer's Market Rules and Regulations.
7. The Penn Avenue parking spots are reserved for produce selling vendors.
8. No vendors are to be set up on, or impeding the use of, any sidewalk or public walkway.
9. The Market Manager is authorized by Borough Council to enforce compliance with the parking rules and regulations set forth herein.
10. The Market Manager is authorized by Borough Council to inspect all products for sale to ensure the products are safe and appropriate for Market consumers.
12. Each vendor is expected to keep the Market free of all trash, refuse and debris caused by their business activities. Should a vendor leave trash, refuse or debris, the Borough will charge the vendor a \$25.00 fee to offset the charge to clean the trash, refuse or debris

13. During hours of operation, all vendors are expected to comply with all Borough Ordinances, including but not limited to those prohibiting alcoholic beverages in the Market and those regulating animals.
14. Vendors are expected to be in compliance with all Commonwealth, County and Borough laws, rules, ordinances and regulations addressing product and business practices.
15. These Rules and Regulations are subject to change from time to time to better serve the Farmer's Market. A notice will be given of any changes before changes take effect.
